Younger/Davis Undergraduate Scholarship Selection Criteria:

Younger/Davis Scholarships are available to family members who qualify under the following guidelines:

- 1. Applicant shall be eligible to receive a scholarship if he/she is a member of the Younger/Davis family and he /she can provide the name and relationship of the matriarch/patriarch from his/her branch of the family in the scholarship application.
- 2. Applicant shall be eligible to receive a scholarship between the first and fourth years of undergraduate studies to include technical school, junior college, community college, and any recognized public/private college or university. Applicant is eligible for a scholarship up until but not to exceed the age of 25 regardless of the year in college.
- 3. Applicant must complete the application and respond to all questions as required by the Selection Committee. The required essay must be 250 to 500 words and must be typewritten.
- 4. Applicant must submit at least one letter of reference from a Younger/Davis family member who has direct knowledge and will provide written verification of the applicant's academic plans; name address and telephone number must be included in the letter.
- 5. Applicant will submit proof of attending college. Proof can be a letter of acceptance, registration form or any document provided on school letterhead that provides proof of registration or attendance.
- 6. Applicant will submit his/her application to be received electronically on or before June 15. Applicant understands that late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- 7. Applicant agrees to notify the President if academic plans change after the submission of an application or after receipt of the scholarship.
- 8. Applicant must submit written notification confirming receipt of the scholarship monies no later than two weeks after receipt to the scholarship President.
- 9. Applicant will submit a picture of themselves to be included with the scholarship application.

The Selection Committee will review and consider, then forward each application to the President. Younger/Davis Scholarships are awarded based on the availability of funds.
